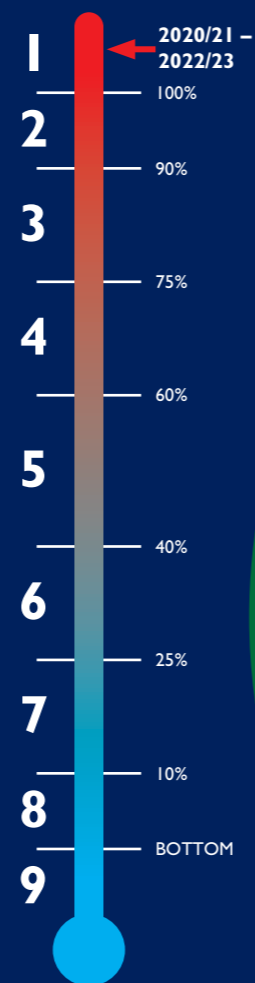
## ALPS

The 124-seat lecture theatre is a key aspect of our Sixth Form, with students learning in a university-style setting.

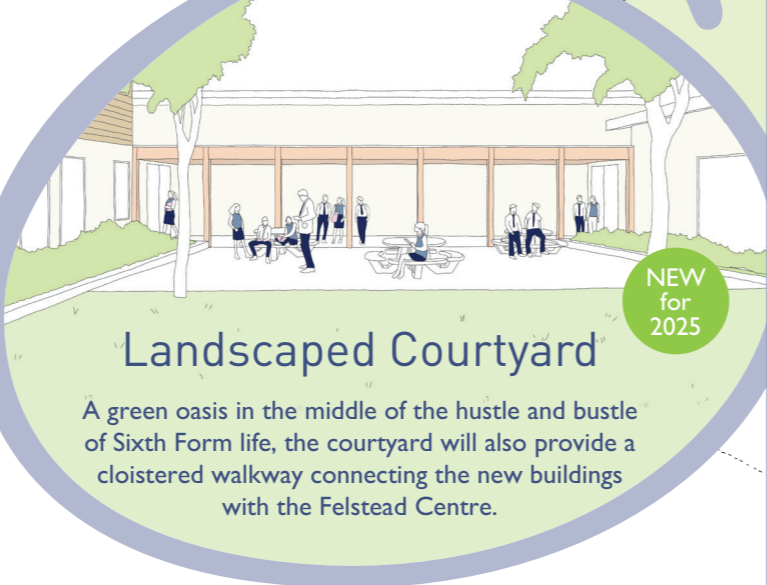


Architect's plans show how the Sixth Form will be developed to accommodate the co-ed intake from September 2025
